 Seminar on May 9 or 10 (not both) at CETLA—unless you completed CETLA's Course Redesign
 Seminar within the past three years.
- If you plan to teach 100% online, register instead for CETLA's online seminar Best Practices in Distance-Learning (June 6 10)—unless you have already earned DL certification from CETLA.

Participants who fulfill these training requirements will be approved for 1/3 stipend in June. Finalists who do not fulfill the training requirements in time will not be eligible to participate in this HU-Teach cycle. Moreover, finalists who do not meet the course submission deadlines (see the "Timetable") will not advance in the HU-Teach design process, unless they can document an emergency.
